High School Students: Are you interested in learning more about ending poverty and homelessness in Philadelphia?

Project HOME offers rising 9th to 12th grade students a summer service opportunity focused on learning about issues of poverty and homelessness, building relationships with others involved in social change, getting to know persons who have experienced poverty and homelessness, and engaging in service with Project HOME and other agencies fighting poverty, hunger and homelessness in Philadelphia. This experience is designed to deepen students' desire to be of service, understanding of Project HOME's mission, knowledge of the issues of poverty and homelessness and the systems that impact these issues, experience of diversity, and connections with other teens interested in serving their community.

Program fee of \$100 is required to participate in the program. Scholarships are available. Please request scholarship assistance on the application.

Students must be available for the whole session for which they apply. As part of participating in the program, students will be asked to commit to hosting a homelessness awareness session in their school community and/or hosting a collection drive in their school community.
